TRR Start Line Area

GENERAL NOTES

- Your coach can't help you here. Have your plan in advance.
- Be alert for megaphone instructions from marshals. Make visual contacts. High density of boats - mind your space and power.

STAGING AREA

- Proceed to the STAGING area and wait for a Marshal to advance you to the QUEUING area.
- The STAGING area is meant to collect boats together for the next two or three races.

QUEING AREA


 The QUEING Marshal will sequence boats in bow number order and pass them into the turn to the START LINE Marshal.

START LINE MARSHAL

- The START LINE Marshal will sequence boats in a zipper fashion, odd and even, in strict bow number order to the Start Line.
- Once past the START LINE Marshal, direct your attention to the Start Line for instructions to raise power and start your race.
- Large orange buoys mark the Start Line. Red and Green buoys will mark the course well into the first turn.

WARM-UP AREA UPRIVER FROM THE START

- The area above the Start Line on the portion of the river adjacent to Tyng Island is available as a warm-up area for experienced crews. We do not recommend that novice boats enter this area.
- If you do elect to row beyond the Start line, please proceed in a counter-clockwise pattern. Keep Tyng Island on your starboard when traveling upriver, then make a left turn to proceed down to the Start on the opposite side of the river from the island.
- This section of the river is extremely tight single file only, with cautious passing.



•	Be aware of the start time of your event; return back to the Start Marshal area in plenty of time to join your race in bow number or	der.
